Education Program Sponsorship Opportunities

Fundraising Goal: \$10,000

Program Focus: Educational resources, workshops, and information that empower individuals with spina bifida, families, caregivers, and professionals across Iowa.

Education sponsors help ensure families and individuals have access to trusted information, practical tools, and lifelong learning opportunities that improve independence and quality of life.

Clinical Care & Advocacy Program Sponsorship Opportunities

Fundraising Goal: \$10,000

Program Focus: The Clinical Care & Advocacy Program advances policies, healthcare access, and clinical excellence for individuals living with spina bifida across Iowa. Through advocacy training and engagement experiences, SBAIA equips individuals and families to effectively engage with local, state, and national representatives and advocate for policies that improve healthcare access, independence, and quality of life.

In parallel, SBAIA partners with clinicians, healthcare staff, hospitals, and medical organizations to strengthen clinical care for people with spina bifida. This includes providing education and resources for providers, supporting professional development, hosting collaborative educational programming, and advancing efforts to establish and expand Spina Bifida-specific clinics. Together, these efforts improve care coordination, clinical expertise, and long-term health outcomes for the spina bifida community.

Social Programs Sponsorship Opportunities

Fundraising Goal: \$20,000

Programs Included:

Program Focus:

SBAIA's Social Programs create meaningful connections, reduce isolation, and build peer support across the lifespan for individuals living with spina bifida and their families. These programs foster community, shared learning, mentorship, and emotional support.

Social Program sponsors help ensure individuals and families have opportunities to connect, share experiences, and build a supportive network throughout Iowa.

Grant Assistance Program (GAP) Sponsorship Opportunities

Fundraising Goal: \$20,000

Program Focus:

The Grant Assistance Program (GAP) provides critical financial support to individuals living with spina bifida when essential needs fall outside traditional funding sources. GAP helps cover costs related to healthcare, mobility, independence, and quality of life—ensuring individuals and families are not left without support when gaps arise.

Through GAP, SBAIA provides funding for uncovered medical expenses, medical supplies, custom footwear and prosthetics, adaptive and recreational opportunities, travel and lodging related to medical care, and additional supports that help individuals live safely and independently. The program also funds **college scholarships for students with spina bifida and camp scholarships for children with spina bifida**, expanding access to education, inclusion, and life enhancing experiences.

GAP sponsorships directly impact individuals and families by meeting immediate needs today while supporting long term growth, confidence, and opportunity.

Camp So Bright: Family Camp Sponsorship Opportunities

Fundraising Goal: \$25,000

Program Overview:

Camp So Bright is a **three night, four day family camp experience** designed for individuals living with spina bifida and their families, including children and adults. This inclusive camp provides a safe, accessible, and empowering environment where families can connect, recharge, and create lifelong memories together.

Campers participate in a wide range of adaptive and traditional camp activities, including fishing, kayaking, swimming, zip lining, climbing, outdoor games, and more. Camp So Bright offers families a rare opportunity to experience camp together—without barriers—while building community, confidence, and joy.
